The 11th Panhellenic Symposium of Oceanography & Fisheries (11th Symposium) will be held at the premises of the University of the Aegean, Mytilene, **from Thursday 14th till Sunday 17th of May 2015**. The official opening ceremony of the Symposium will take place on Wednesday 13th of May 2015. The Symposium is coorganized by the Panhellenic Union of HCMR Employees and the Union of HCMR Researchers, under the auspices of the Hellenic Centre for Marine Research, in collaboration with the Department of Marine Sciences, University of the Aegean.

Submissions will be accepted **until November 15**th **2014**. Contributions (Oral or Poster presentations) should be relevant to the following topics:

INSTRUCTIONS TO AUTHORS

All contributions should comply with the detailed instructions to authors. Instructions and the relevant <u>template</u> for submission are available on the Symposium website. Authors are invited to submit their contributions electronically, using the provided <u>submission form</u>. Text length including figures and tables should not exceed four (4) pages.

Each submission should be accompanied by the <u>registration form</u> which is also available on the Symposium website.

REVIEW PROCESS

Submitted papers will be reviewed by two Referees. A third Referee will review the paper, in case one of the two original Referees rejects it. Authors will be informed on the outcome of the review process at the latest on **January 15th, 2015.** Authors will be required to send their revised and final submissions until **February 15th, 2015.** Please also include a detailed response to reviewers, stating how you dealt with their comments.

Payment of the registration fees by (at least) one of the authors is a prerequisite for acceptance. Each revised contribution should thus be accompanied by a proof of payment of the registration fees. Payment details will be available on the symposium website.

PUBLISHING PROCESS

Papers presented at the 11th Panhellenic Symposium of Oceanography & Fisheries will be posted in PDF format on the Symposium's website, prior to May 13th and the official opening of the Symposium. For this reason, authors must meet the submission and resubmission deadlines, to allow the publication of the Symposium Proceedings in time.

The Scientific Journal of HCMR "Mediterranean Marine Science" as well as that of the University of the Aegean "Global NEST Journal" will publish the full text of selected contributions in a Special Issue. Manuscript selection will be made according to the reviewing process of the above journals.

In addition, the Symposium Organizing Committee will offer two "Kostas Nittis" awards to the best presentations (a poster and an oral presentation respectively) of young scientists.
