Transnational Conference and Stakeholder Workshop - ADRIatic Ionian maritime spatial PLANning (ADRIPLAN)

On Friday the 28th of February 2014, at the City of Rijeka in Croatia, the first ADRIPLAN project's event will be held at the City Hall.

During the Transnational Conference and the Stakeholders' Workshop the ADRIPLAN project will be presented and the following issues (themes) will be discussed in parallel thematic workshops with the active involvement of all the participants:

1. Transport - Routes and port infrastructures, to strengthen and integrate the system, for goods and passengers
2. Oil & Gas and Energy (infrastructures, energy from sea, mining)
3. Coastal defence and protection and Climate Change Adaptation in coastal areas, including strategic sand deposits for beach protection and nourishment
4. Fisheries, aquaculture, and Marine Protected Areas
5. Limits and developing of coastal tourism

The event will launch the dialogue on Maritime Spatial Planning issues of concern in the Adriatic-Ionian region with key stakeholders, considering also the results of the EUSAIR consultation recently performed by the EC.

The meeting will be attended by representatives of the European Commission and the Public Administrations of the Countries of the Adriatic-Ionian region, by members of the Scientific Community, as well as by public and private economic sectors.
