On 13th February 2024 the 2nd workshop of the project "Epirus Waters" was organized by the Institute of Marine Biological Resources and Inland Waters (IMBRIW) of HCMR and funded by the Green Fund.

In the workshop 15 scientists from 9 different public authorities that are related to water monitoring and management, participated, including the Region of Epirus, the Decentralized Administration of Epirus - Western Macedonia, the Protected Areas Management Unit of Epirus - N.E.C.C.A. and the Hydrobiological Station of Ioannina.

The aim of the meeting was to present the network of automatic water monitoring stations developed within the project, as well as to illustrate the benefits from the project output with respect to the mitigation of natural and anthropogenic disasters.

In the context of a constructive discussion, proposals for the better utilization of the automatic stations were analysed and it was agreed that the meetings with the project team should be continued, for the optimization and expansion of the network.
